

Materials List for Sixth Grade

(2018- 2019 School Year)

We would like to welcome you to Long River Middle School. To facilitate a smooth transition to middle school as a grade level, we have compiled a list of materials for incoming sixth graders. To help students with their organizational skills as they switch classes, we are requesting binders, book covers, and folders to be color coordinated by subjects across the grade level.

Each student should have the following supplies for:

Science- a one-inch three ring binder (BLUE), a two pocket folder (BLUE), a pack of loose leaf paper (reinforced edges if possible), and a package of tabbed dividers (5-6) for the three ring binder .

Social Studies- a two pocket folder (GREEN) and a one subject notebook (GREEN)

Math- a one-inch three ring binder (RED), a two pocket folder (RED), a pack of loose leaf paper (reinforced edges if possible), and a package of tabbed dividers for the three ring binder.

Language Arts- a two pocket folder (BLACK) and a composition notebook (BLACK)

Chorus - a two pocket folder

Band- Instrument, pencil, two-pocket folder, reeds (for clarinet and saxophone size 2 or 2 ½), valve oil (for trumpet), slide grease (for trombone), Tradition of Excellence book 1 for their specific instrument (red cover)

In addition, they will need the following supplies for the entire school year. Some supplies may need to be replenished as the year progresses.

1. Ruler
2. Two black and two blue pens
3. One red pen
4. Pencils with erasers and a soft pencil case
5. Four highlighters- (yellow, green, blue, pink)
6. A hand-held pencil sharpener
7. Colored pencils
8. Earbuds / headphones
9. Sticky notes (3"x 3")

Each student should have the following study materials and supplies available at home:

crayons, colored pencils, markers, glue sticks, and scissors.
